General Information:

1. Team registration will begin at 10:00am on Saturday, March 11th, and 9:00am on Sunday, March 12th. Please report one hour prior to your first scheduled game. The registration table is in Lilly Center lobby just outside of Court #1.
2. Coaches are responsible for having a copy of each athlete's *Medical Form* at the tournament. Forms will be checked during team registration. **Any athlete who does not have a *Medical Form* on-site will not be allowed to participate.**
3. Line-up cards should be completed and presented to the scorers table at least 10 minutes prior to the game.

4. In Unified Sports games, the Partners must not score more than 75% of the team's total points, and the Athletes must not score more than 75% of the team's total points. Thus, in a game, the Athletes as a group and the Partners as a group must score at least 25% of the total points scored. **Failure to adhere to the required ratio will result in a forfeit.**
5. The DePauw Panhellenic Association will be hosting games and activities for our athletes which will be available both Saturday and Sunday during competition. Prizes will be available! They have put in a lot of hard work to make this possible, so please have your athletes take advantage of this opportunity!
6. Opening Ceremonies will take place at 1:30pm on Court #1. The Mayor of Greencastle and the President of DePauw University will be in attendance to speak. Everyone is highly encouraged to attend!
7. Awards will be presented on the court following each game of the medal round. A separate area will be available for team photos.
8. Souvenirs will be available on both Saturday and Sunday.
9. Concessions will be available in the Lilly Center. Food is also available in the Student Union, and there are several local restaurants near campus.
10. The Inn at DePauw is a hotel located on the campus of DePauw University. If unavailable, there are other hotel/motel options in the Greencastle, Cloverdale, and Plainfield areas.

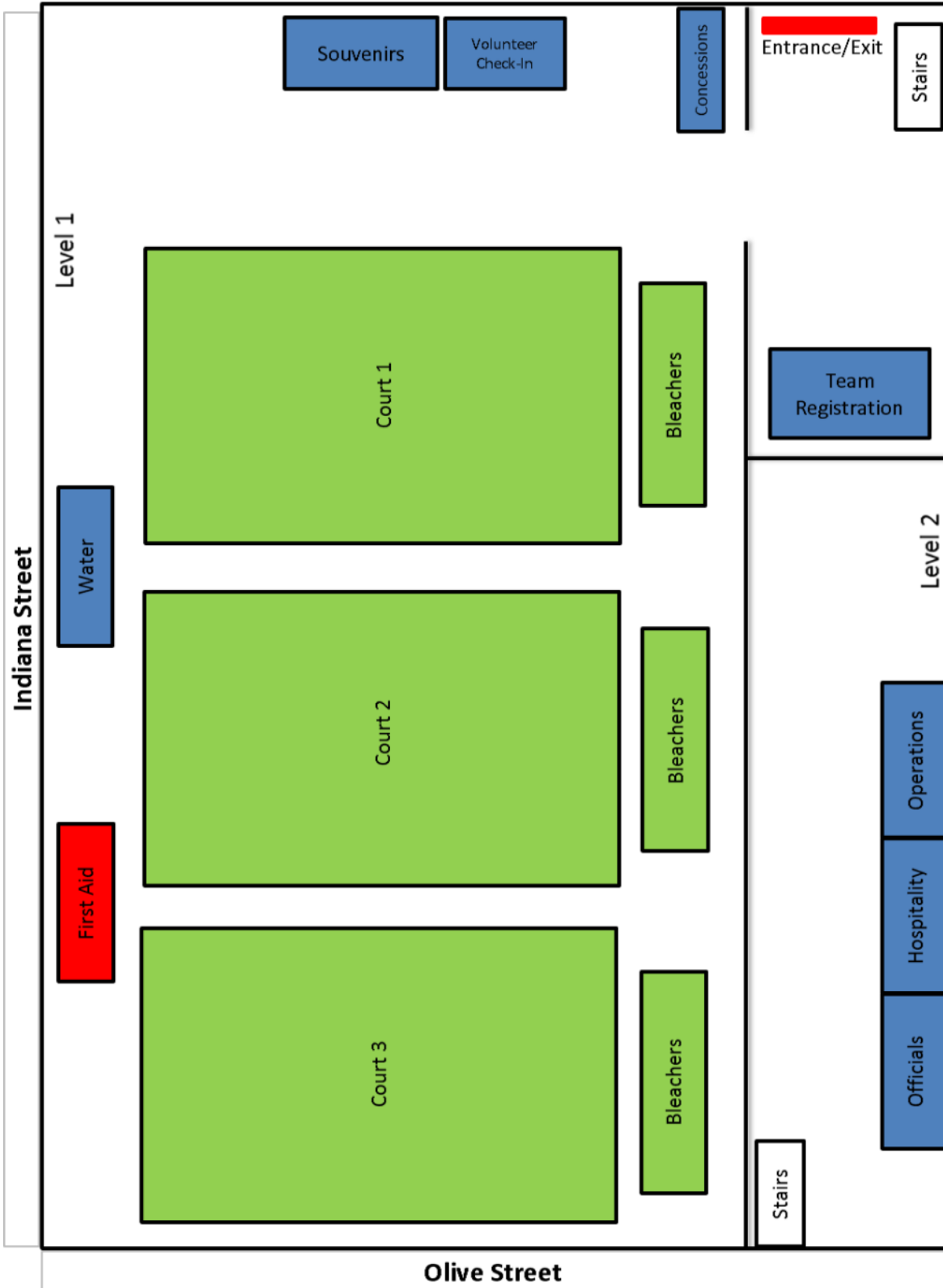
Parking Map
