## Team and Venue Information

### Tournament Game Schedule

Game times and court assignments are listed on the schedule for the day, which can be found on page 8. Games will be played in Nicoson Hall and the Ruth Lilly Fitness Center, which are connected through an indoor hallway. Courts 1 and 2 will be in Nicoson Hall and Courts 3 and 4 will be in the Ruth Lilly Fitness Center. Please note that there will be an hour break from 12pm - 1pm so athletes can participate in the Rally.

### Registration and Check-in

Registration tables will be set up in the west lobby of Nicoson Hall from 8:15am - 1:30pm for team competition. A registration table for individual skills will be set up at the bottom of the stairs in Ruth Lilly Fitness Center, just outside the west entrance to the courts, at 8:50 am. **Any athlete who does not have a *Medical Form* on-site will not be allowed to participate.**

### Changing Area

If teams need access to a changing area, there are restrooms located on the east and west ends of Nicoson Hall, as well as the north end of Ruth Lilly Fitness Center.

### Medical

There will be a certified athletic trainer in each gym at all times along with athletic training students. Students and certified trainers will be located on the main floor of the gym with students in opposite corners. Although water and cups are provided, we ask that athletes bring water bottles to refill as cups may run out.

### Awards

Court captains will notify coaches if the game is for a medal or not prior to tipoff. After the game, the court captains will hand the coach a slip of paper showing the team's place in the division. If your game was on Courts 3 or 4, proceed to the awards table just outside the west entrance to court 4 (downstairs). If your game was on Courts 1 or 2, proceed to the awards table outside Room 128 in Ruth Lilly (upstairs). Volunteers will take the names of the teams based on the order they check in and then will give an estimated wait time. While they wait, teams can enjoy the special events, or wait in Room 014 (downstairs) or Room 142 (upstairs). Teams will be staged prior to receiving their awards and then called up to the podium when it's time for the ceremony. Family will be allowed to take pictures while team is on stage. Please exit through the opposite door in Room 128 or towards the stairs if you're in the area outside Court 4. Any questions may be directed towards James Fields. Please see the venue diagram on page 11 for visual aids.



## Team and Venue Information Continued

### Skills

Registration opens at 8:50 am. Athletes will check-in on lower level of the Ruth Lilly Fitness Center outside the west entrance to Court 4. Athletes can take the elevator or the stairs as the registration table will be located by both. Individual Skills Competition will be held on Court 4 in the Ruth Lilly Fitness Center and the first division will start at 9:00am. Seating for family and friends is on the upper level of the Ruth Lilly Fitness Center. Divisions 1 and 2 will start at 9 a.m., divisions 3 and 4 will start at 9:30am, divisions 5 and 6 will start at 10am, and division 7 will start at 10:30am. Please plan to arrive 10 minutes before your division's start time and stay near the check in table afterwards, as awards will take place shortly after the completion of your competition. The schedule for the Skills Competition will be on page 9.

### Rally/Opening Ceremonies

A rally will take place at 12pm to get the athletes excited for the day. Athletes will meet in the tunnel off the west end of Court 2 by 11:45am or immediately their game if playing at 11am or 11:30am. Athletes will be organized by county program, and signs will be lined up throughout the tunnel so athletes know where to stand. Teams will be accompanied by UIndy student-athletes while they walk around the courts of Nicoson Hall before taking a seat on the courts. There will be some guest speakers to get the athletes excited before they take their oath. UIndy cheerleading and dance teams will come out with UIndy mascot, Ace, to perform a pump-up song before being dismissed by the emcee.

### Concessions

Concessions will be available at the concession stand in Nicoson Hall throughout the day.

### Souvenirs

Special Olympics Indiana souvenirs and merchandise will be available for purchase on the main level of Nicoson Hall near concessions to commemorate the weekend's activities.

### Need Assistance?

Tournament staff and volunteers will be happy to answer any questions you or your parents may have. Staff and volunteers will be wearing Special Olympics polos and t-shirts, and will be visible throughout the venue. You may also contact or ask for any of the tournament staff listed previously in the manual.



## Special Events

All the following activities will be held throughout the day in the Ruth Lilly Fitness Center unless specifically noted.

### **Healthy Athletes: Fit Feet – Room 114 (10am - 2pm)**

We will be offering foot screenings in room 114 in Ruth Lilly from 10am - 2pm. Be sure to have your athletes drop by for free screenings and giveaways!

### **Nintendo Wii – Room 130**

Athletes will be able to play one (1) game of Just Dance, Outdoor Adventure, or Wii Sports.

### **Angry Birds – Room 130**

Athletes will play the real life version of Angry Birds by throwing Angry Birds at the Bad Pigs.

### **Play Area – Room 132**

Athletes will choose to play a color matching game, ball toss with a partner, race against others by using a scooter, match motions with a scarf, or keep a beach ball up in the air.

### **Press Conference Station – Room 132**

Athletes can imagine they are at an official press conference. They will answer questions as if they are being interviewed after a big game!

### **Art Station – Room 132**

Players will be able to color a coloring page of their choice.

### **UIndy Ultimate Frisbee Team – Ruth Lilly Racquetball Courts (11am – 1:45pm)**

Athletes will learn how to throw a Frisbee and play games like Frisbee Flip and Tic-Tac-Toe.

### **UIndy Women's Basketball Team – Ruth Lilly Racquetball Courts (2pm – 3pm)**

Athletes will play dribbling games with the UIndy Women's Basketball team.

### **Photo Booth Station – Northeast Corner of Nicoson Hall**

Athletes will be able to take fun photos with their teammates, coaches, or loved ones to remember their time at the 2017 Special Olympics Indiana Youth State Basketball Tournament.

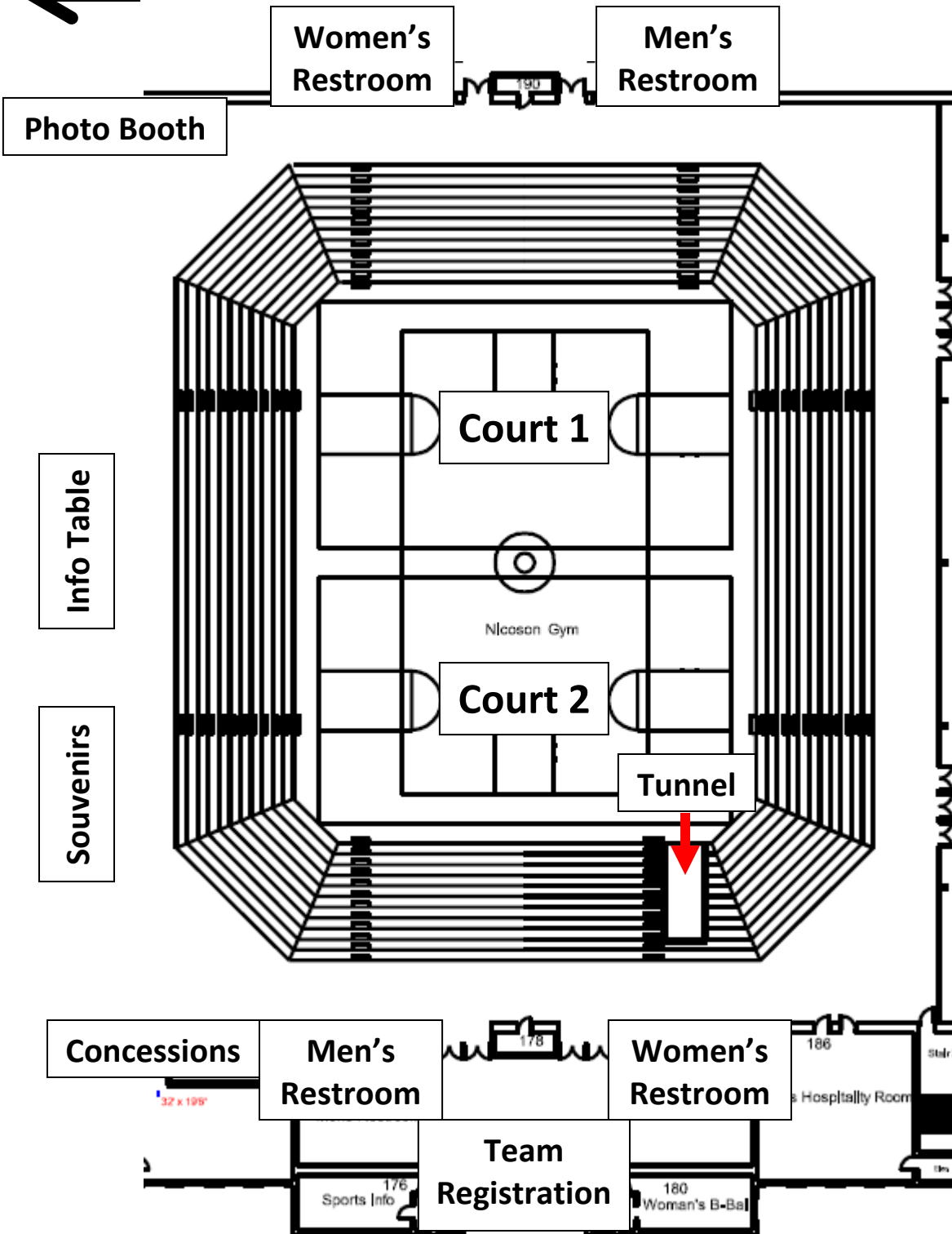

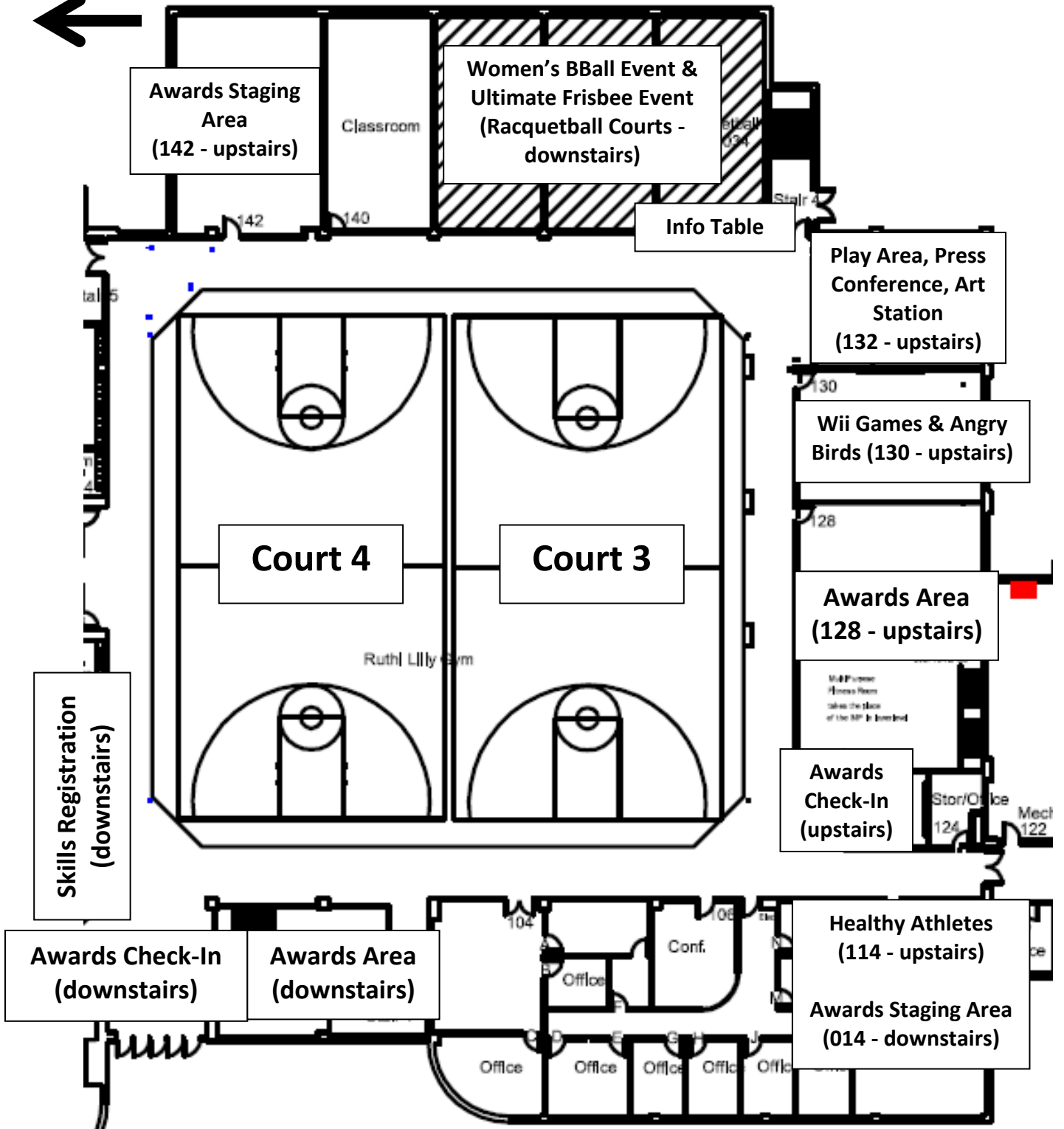

Take I-65 south to Keystone Avenue (Exit 107). Turn right onto Keystone Ave until Hanna Ave where you will turn right. Go through two stoplights until you reach Campus Drive where Nicoson Hall is on your right.

### From the North

Take US 31 south to I-465 east, take I-465 east until I-65 north (exit 53A). See directions **From the South** below.

### From the East

Go to I-465 south until I-65 north (exit 53A). See directions **From the South** below.

### From the Southeast

Take I-74 northwest to I-465, take I-465 south until I-65 north (Exit 53A). See directions **From the South** below.

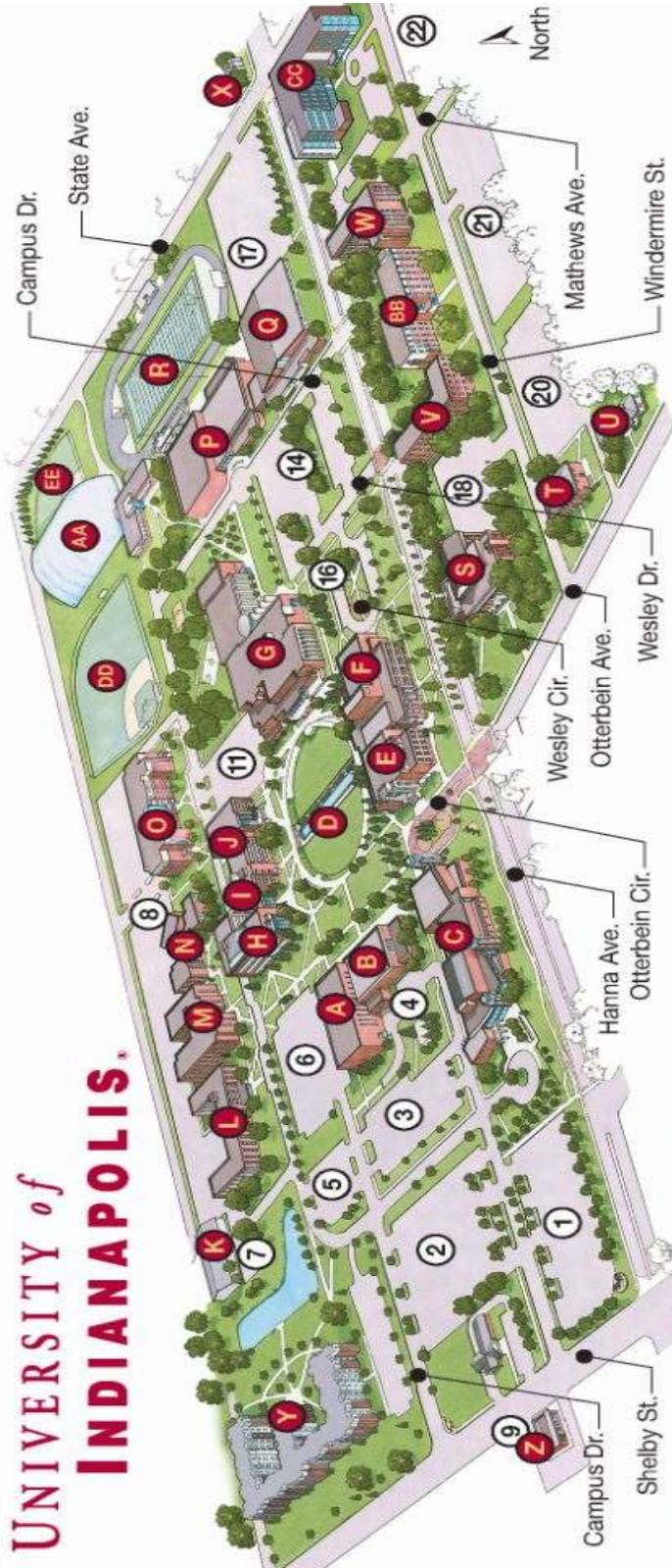
### From the South
