JOB SUMMARY

Development Intern will assist with the planning and implementation of fundraising and other special events.

PERFORMANCE DIMENSIONS AND TASKS

1. Special Event

Assist with planning and implementation of fundraising events during the season of the internship. (Polar Plunge, Summer Games, FedEx Plane Pull, Law Enforcement Torch Run, Charity Golf Classic, etc.). Assist with acknowledgement of gifts, donations, and pledges, including incentive prize fulfillment. Assist with obtaining donations of cash and in-kind for related events. Assist with related marketing for special events.

2. Project Coordination

Assist in planning and implementation of projects as assigned.

3. Administration/Budgets

Assist with after-action reports for special events. Assist with tracking donors from fundraising events. Utilize existing database for special events.

4. Project Assistance

Assist as needed with other Special Olympics projects. This could include office/administrative tasks, loading and unloading, physical set-up of venues, meetings, trainings, customer service and other activities associated with the general operation of Special Olympics.
