



Barn Rules for Hendricks County 4-H Fairgrounds

- 1) **Horses are not to arrive before 2:00 PM Friday.**
- 2) Arena hours (A, B & C) on Friday are 3:00 PM - 5:00 PM and 6:30 PM – 9:00 PM You can use the round pins in the back. Horses are not to be tacked after 10:00 PM and the barn must be vacated by 11:00 PM (Friday) and 6:00 PM Saturday. All Horse Riders (including volunteers and athletes) must wear helmets at all times.
- 3) **For safety sake, please keep the barn aisles clear.** Each Riding Center are given extra stalls in addition to tack stalls for congregation.
- 4) Only Competitors and Horse Handlers are allowed in the Tack Check & Staging Area.
- 5) Only ride in designated areas (arenas, warm-up pens). In any other areas your horse must be led.
- 6) Always ride with a person in visible site of you.
- 7) Proper attire must be worn (boots with heels, Jeans or breeches, etc.).
- 8) **ASTM helmets must be worn at all times while working with a horse.**
- 9) Dismount in the dismounting area and lead your horse back to the stall.
- 10) Clean up after your horse and yourself, including any trash you may have.
- 11) **Every program must clean their own stalls.** Please make sure your stalls have been checked by the Barn Manager or his assistant before leaving the barn as you depart.
- 12) Return any wheelbarrows, brooms or other equipment to the storage area after you are finished using them.
- 13) Notify the Barn Manager of any problems with stalls in disrepair or any safety related issues.
- 14) In case you have an ill or injured horse, please notify one of the Sport Management Team Members to contact the vet (or let them know if you contacted your own vet). The Hendricks County Animal Hospital is on-call for our needs during the weekend.
- 15) In case of a shoe issue with one of your horses, come to the registration area for the Ferrier to be contacted. Ferrier is onsite.
