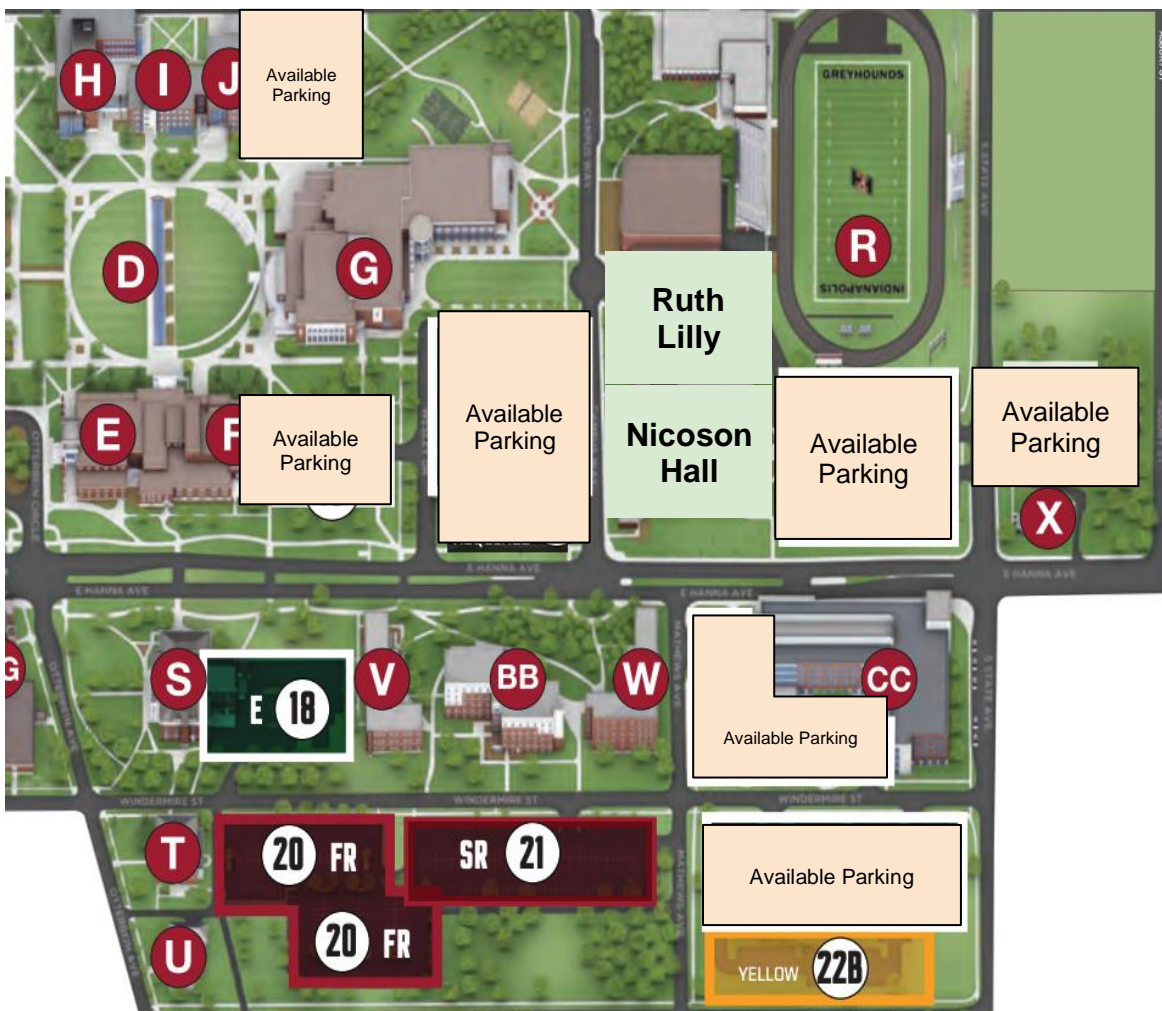
COVID-19 Protocol

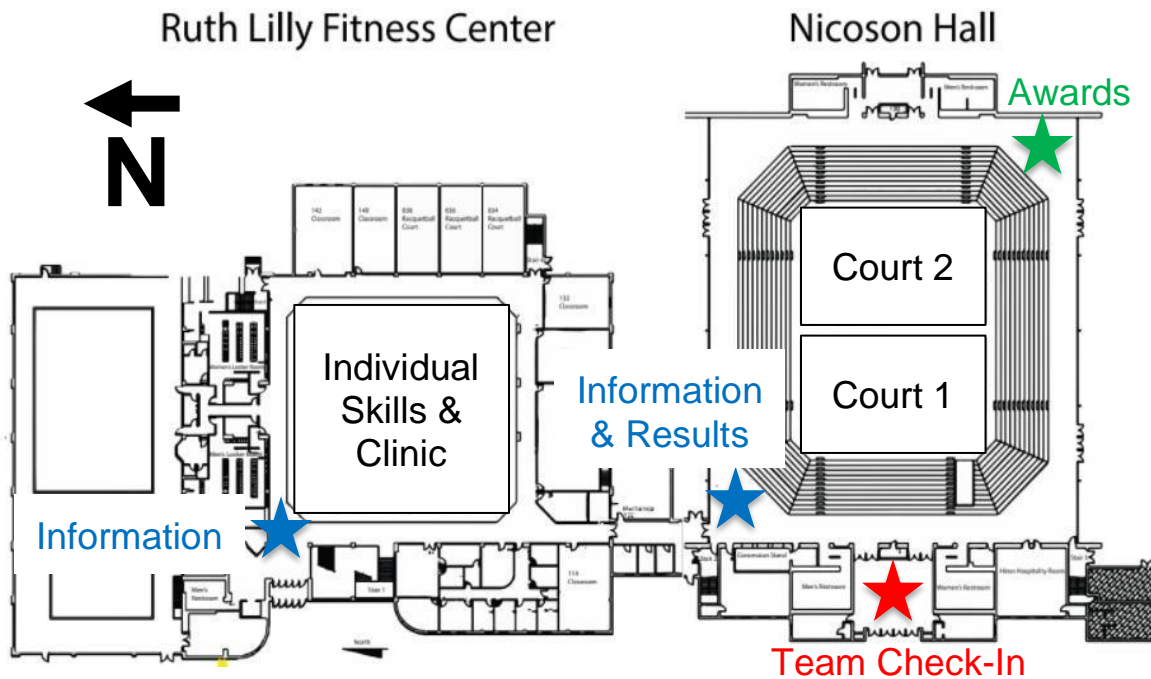
- Masks are optional, but recommended, regardless of your vaccination status.

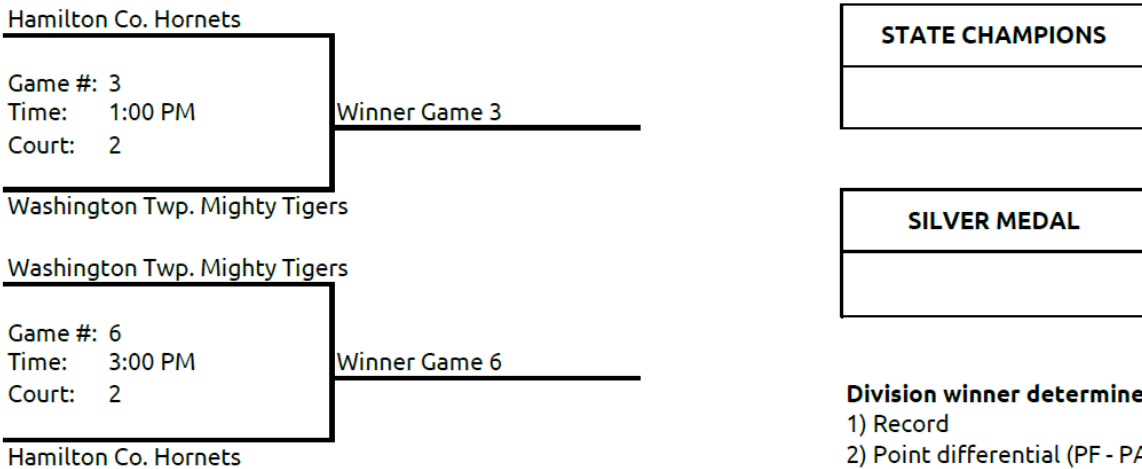

Opening-Ceremony

The opening ceremony will take place from 10:40 AM - 11:30 AM in Nicoson Hall. Please sit in the south bleachers of Nicoson Hall.

Team Awards

Awards will take place in the southeast corner of Nicoson Hall (see green star on facility diagram). Awards for team competition will be presented to each team after their final game. Please report to the awards area immediately after your team's final game. You will be given further instructions by the awards volunteers.

Skills Awards

Awards will take place in the southeast corner of Nicoson Hall (see green star on facility diagram). Awards for the skills competition will be presented to each participant at the end of the entire competition (approximately 2:00 PM). Following the conclusion of the skills competition, volunteers will escort the athletes from Ruth Lilly over to Nicoson Hall.

Ancillary Events

Every athlete will receive a punch card at the incentives table located in Ruth Lilly. Before the athletes leave the room/activity they will collect a punch that belongs to the event. Once the athlete has all the boxes punched out in their card head over to the incentives table for a prize! No rush in ancillary events as they will be open from 12:00 PM - 4:00 PM. Basketball Clinic

The University of Indianapolis Women's Basketball Team has put together a clinic for all athletes. The clinic will begin at 9:00 AM in Ruth Lilly. Listed below is a breakdown of what to expect at the morning clinic:

 - 3-man weave
 - 5-man weave to 3 on 2 back
- Ball handling stations
 - Partner station
 - Diamond cone station with finishes
- Shooting stations
 - Working on form
 - Rhythm shooting
- 1v1 comp or 1v1 moves
- King/Queen of the hill

Skills Competition

The skills competition will begin at 10:00 AM in Ruth Lilly. Enter through Ruth Lilly and take the stairs or the elevator down a level. You will check-in at the skills table by giving your name and you will then receive a nametag. Once checked in, you will be staged on the courts by division. Each athlete will participate in the skills competition one at a time. Awards for the skills competition will take place at the end of the entire competition.
