- CHECK-IN:** All coaches should check-in upon arrival. Plan to arrive at least 30 minutes before the coaches meeting.
- MEDICALS:** Your County Medical Report for all registered athletes will be emailed to you. It is best practice for you to have a copy accessible, during travel, and elsewhere, as it includes emergency contact information. This can be in electronic or print format, whichever is most convenient for you. Special Olympics Indiana has this full report. It is also readily accessible by the Sectional Director for the duration of the competition. The accessibility of this information meets the requirement of having all medicals on site. Therefore, there is no requirement to bring any medical or registration paperwork other than this report. Medicals will not be checked at Delegation Check-in.

- You will find out your flight when you check-in. There will be a maximum of 6 teams per flight, and a minimum of 2 teams per flight. Teams will be notified at the tournament as to the number in each division that will move on to state. State Fact Sheets will be available.
- GOLF CARTS:** Golf carts will be used at all stops on the Unified Golf Tour. Please note that the Golf Cart Rules seen on Page 149 of the 2022-2023 Program Information Guide are still in effect for Sectional and State Tournament play. Coaches and spectators will NOT be granted use of golf carts.
- WARM-UP:** There will be a putting green and driving range available for warm-ups.
- RULES:** We will be following Special Olympics Indiana Golf Rules beginning on Page 148 of the *2022-2023 Program Information Guide*.

SMOKING: Smoking is prohibited on the course. All Special Olympics events are smoke-free.

MEALS: There will be a concession stand open throughout the day. Water will be available on the course, but we encourage athletes to bring their own bottles.

FIRST AID: First aid will be available at coaches check-in.

SPECTATORS: Spectators will be allowed to follow their athletes ON-FOOT throughout the course. No golf carts will be given to spectators. Please be respectful of course rules.
