ACTIVITIES

- ORDER the TILES Part 1
 - o In front of you, you will see 9 tiles that all have different words on them.
 - o Some are more positive and some might be more negative
 - o Take a minute to look through the tiles and get familiar with them.
 - o Place them in an order that makes sense to you.
 - There is no right or wrong, it is all about what makes sense to you and how you think the cards should be ordered.
 - Share out with the group.
- ORDER the TILES Part 2
 - o Find a partner (or groups of 3-5) and create an order which you both agree on.
 - Share out with the groups.
- GUESS which TILE
 - o Groups of 3-5
 - o Have one person from the group close eyes and select a tile, and then hold above their head without looking at the card.
 - Other members of the group try to describe the tile without using name of tile or possible descriptive words on back.
 - o Person holding the tile will try to guess what tile it is.
 - Take turns guessing each tile
