GENERAL INFORMATION:

- Head Coach should report to Registration at least 30 minutes prior to competition. There you will verify contact for the county and receive your athlete labels, as well as report any scratches.
- All bowlers MUST compete in the session they have been assigned. Please report to the Session as indicated by the bowler's division above. There will be no switching of sessions.
- All ramp bowlers will bowl 2 games and all other bowlers at this site will bowl 3 games, cross-lane format.
- Medical forms will not be checked at the tournament. Coaches are encouraged to bring the Medical Report supplied by the State Office. The Tournament Director will have a medical report on site.
- Bowlers are not permitted to wear hats during competitions.
- Delegations are responsible for providing their own ramps/adaptive equipment for the bowlers. Ramp bowlers will not cross lanes. Ramp bowlers will bowl five consecutive frames then switch to the next bowler.
- Seating is very limited at this venue. Priority seating is given to all the bowlers who are competing. Observers will not be permitted to sit in the bowler's area. Chairs may be brought in, HOWEVER, it is imperative that a clear walkway is maintained throughout the facility. Please advise your families, staff, providers, etc.
- There will be a 5-minute warm-up, followed by Opening Ceremonies. Awards ceremonies will take place after competition for each division has completed.
- Any athlete arriving after the games have completed four frames, or they miss a game completely, a blind score will be given for that game (Blind score = bowling average -10).

FOOD: Concessions are available. The Terre Haute Bowling Center policy is that NO food or drink may be brought in from outside vendors (NO McDonald's, Arby's, no large drink coolers, etc.).

SMOKING/VAPING: There will be NO smoking or vaping during the bowling competition. The Terre Haute Bowling Center and Special Olympics Indiana provides a smoke-free venue.

ALCOHOL: There is to be no consumption of alcohol during competition.
